

7-Year Limited Solar/RE Warranty Policy

Centennial Battery will provide a 7-year limited warranty for Centennial Deep Cycle batteries used in Solar PV and other Renewable Energy applications. This limited warranty covers batteries that become unusable and unserviceable due to material defects or workmanship. This limited warranty applies only to the original purchaser of the battery and is non-transferable.

For the first two years of this limited warranty we will provide a free replacement. During the free replacement period, Centennial Battery will replace or repair the defective battery with one of equal or greater value. The remaining five years are pro rata. The Pro Rata period is based on our suggested retail price for your replacement battery at the time you return your original battery. A receipt or copy of your purchase invoice must be provided for this period.

The Centennial 7-year limited warranty covers any 85 ampere hour capacity or higher 6 Volt and 12 Volt model batteries. The Centennial 7-year limited Solar Warranty starts from the date the product is sold and applies only to batteries sold in solar and renewable energy applications.

This limited warranty shall not apply due to failure in service from fire, explosion, freezing, abuse, customer negligence, unauthorized modifications or alterations, or installation of a different (smaller) size or capacity battery than is required. This warranty does not cover battery damage from shipping, loose wiring, over-discharging or overcharging, reverse polarity installations, nor breakage of containers, covers or terminal posts. This limited warranty does not cover costs of transportation, shipping, service calls, battery installation, recharging or use of rental batteries. Centennial Battery will not be responsible for electrical systems test, loss of time, loss of equipment use or any other expenses which could be considered incidental or consequential damages. You will need to still pay any taxes or legislatively imposed fees for your replacement battery, and may also need to pay labor and installation charges.
